It is your responsibility to be familiar with and follow the rules and regulations. It is recommended that you obtain a copy of the current West Virginia Fishing Regulations or Hunting Regulations. They are available at authorized Hunting License Agents, online at [wvdnr.gov](http://wvdnr.gov) or contact the CVB at **304.799.INFO (4636)**.

### Hunting

It is required by law all persons over the age of 15 have a current hunting permit. For more information on required permits and bag limits, please visit [wvdnr.gov](http://wvdnr.gov).

### Fishing

It is required by law all persons over the age of 15 have a current fishing permit. For more information on trout stamp requirements, detailed regulations and additional fishing points of interest, please visit [wvdnr.gov](http://wvdnr.gov).

### LAKES

**Seneca State Forest** — This 4-acre lake located in Seneca State Forest is perfect for catching largemouth bass.

**Watoga State Park** — The 11-acre lake in Watoga State Park offers paddle boating, row-boating and fishing (trout, bass, bluegill and catfish).

**Buffalo Lake** — The 21-acre lake located along Route 28 in northern Pocahontas County is great for fishing for trout, bass, bluegill or catfish.

### CATCH AND RELEASE TROUT STREAMS

**Cranberry River** — From the junction of North and South Forks, downstream 4.3 miles to the low water bridge at Dogway Fork. Access by foot on FR76 from the Cranberry Glades parking area.

**North Fork of Cranberry River** — Beginning at the mouth and extending upstream 1/4 mile to the limestone treatment dam. Access by foot on FR76 (Webster County).

**Slatyfork Section of Elk River** — A 3.6-mile section beginning at the junction of Big Spring Fork and Old Field Fork and extending downstream to the railroad bridge. Access by foot from state secondary route 219/2 on the north and 219/12 on the south.

**Williams River** — Beginning 2 miles below Tea Creek and extending downstream 2 miles. Access by FR86.

## PUBLIC HUNTING LAND

Pocahontas County has over 500,000 acres of available public hunting land ranging from wildlife management areas to national forest. Listed below are some of the available lands. ### WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREAS

#### CRANBERRY WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA: 158,147 ACRES

- Bear, deer, snowshoe hare, squirrel, turkey
- Elevations ranging from 1,900 to 4,600 feet in mountainous terrain covered with mature hardwood forests
- State Route 150, 39, 7, 48, and 46 provide access to the area

#### HANDLEY WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA: 784 ACRES

- Bear, deer, grouse, turkey, waterfowl, woodcock
- Rolling hills and scattered steep slopes covered in hardwood forest, about 10% of the area is openings
- State Route 17, which intersects U.S. Route 219 at Edray, approximately four miles north of Marlinton. From the Highland Scenic Highway, turn south on FR86 (Williams River Road) and State Route 17/4 following WVDNR signs to the area

#### LITTLE RIVER WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA: 124,983 ACRES

- Bear, deer, grouse, snowshoe hare, squirrel, turkey, woodcock, bobcat, fox, raccoon
- Northern hardwoods cover the mountainous terrain with oak-hickory and black cherry; white pine and red pine also present
- Access the area from U.S. Route 250, as well as State Route 28 and 92

#### NEOLA WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA: 104,750 ACRES

- Bear, deer, grouse, rabbit, squirrel, turkey, waterfowl
- Oak-hickory and oak-pine forest cover 90% of the rugged terrain
- Access is available from State Route 92 and 39

#### RIMEL WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA: 67,251 ACRES

- Bear, deer, grouse, rabbit, squirrel, turkey
- Mountainous terrain with oak-hickory, oak-pine and northern hardwood forests
- Access is by state routes 39, 28, 92, and 84. Thirty miles of paved roads and 46 miles of unpaved secondary roads traverse the area

#### SLATYFORK WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA: 79 ACRES

- Deer, squirrel, turkey
- Northern hardwoods cover the mountainous terrain with oak-hickory, black cherry, white pine and red pine also present
- Turn off U.S. route 219 at Beckwith Lumber Company near Slatyfork onto a gravel road that travels through the lumber company's property. This road terminates at WVDNR parking lot

#### TEA CREEK WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA: 67,919 ACRES

- Bear, deer, grouse, snowshoe hare, squirrel, turkey
- Northern hardwood forest cover the mountainous terrain
- State Route 39 and the Highland Scenic Highway Route 150

### STATE FORESTS

#### CALVIN PRICE STATE FOREST: 2482 ACRES

- Older age deer management area, bear, grouse, squirrel, turkey
- Moderately rugged, covered in mixed hardwoods and pine
- Accessible from State Route 39 east of Marlinton

\*Restrictions: Point and width restrictions on deer, contact WVDNR for details

#### SENECA STATE FOREST: 11,684 ACRES

- Bear, deer, grouse, squirrel, turkey
- Pine-hardwood forest cover the gently sloping to hilly terrain ranging in elevation from 2,000 to 3,600 feet
- Area is along State Route 28, 10 miles south of Green Bank



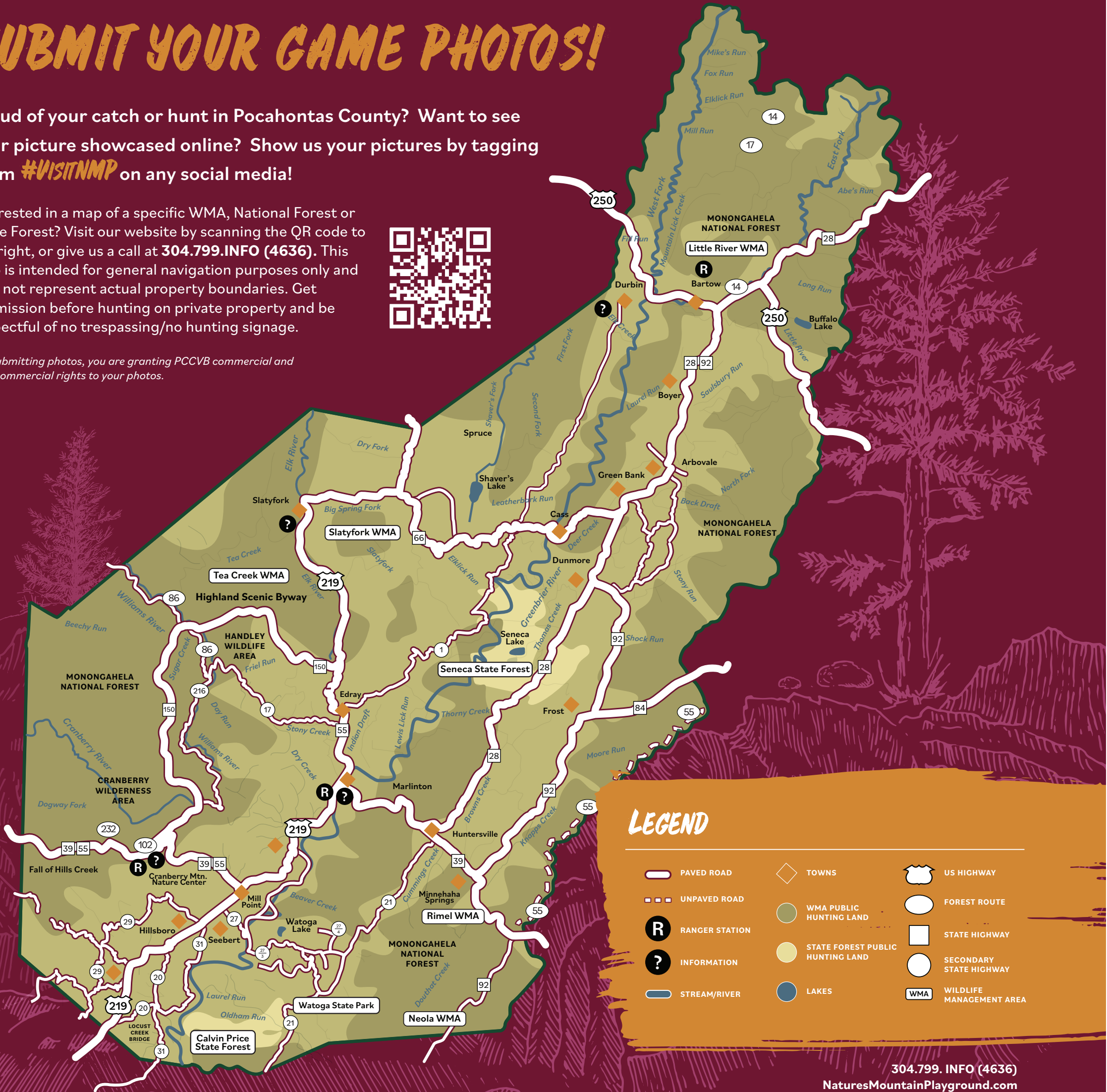
