Pocahontas County: Visitor Research

- State of Origin
 - WV, VA, NC, OH, PA, MD, KY, SC, TN, DC
- Primary Age Demographics
 - Age 18-44 = **52%,** Age 45-65+ = **48%**
- Average HHI = 42% +\$100,000 (combined annually)
- Primary Activity/Purpose of Trip
 - Skiing/Snowboarding; visiting Snowshoe Resort
 - Scenic Train Rides
 - Visiting Green Bank Observatory
 - Hiking
 - Mountain Biking
- Hiking is the most popular activity reported, with **41%** of all visitors partaking in hiking while in Pocahontas County

Economic Impact: Outdoor Recreation

Outdoor Recreation Continues to Stimulate Local Economies

- In 2023, outdoor recreation generated \$1.2 TRILLION in economic output, a 5% increase versus 2022
- In the US, the outdoor recreation industry created 5 MILLION jobs, accounting for 3.1% of of all US employees in 2023
- Snowshoe Highlands, West Virginia's first and only IMBA
 Designated Ride Center, is home to a vast 35,000 acres of trail
 systems; mountain biking generates more than \$48 MILLION in
 regional economies annually, contributing to \$30 MILLION of
 total visitor spending in the US
- In WV, spending in outdoor recreation rose to **\$1.5 BILLION**, accounting for **24%** of total visitor spending in 2023

Pocahontas County Tourism = Steady Economic Growth

- In 2023, Pocahontas County saw \$148 MILLION in annual visitor spending, with a 44% increase in occupancy tax collection since the COVID19 pandemic
- Tourism in Pocahontas County directly saves residents \$1,400 in annual property taxes
- The average group spending per trip to Pocahontas County is \$1,598, which directly supports our local tourism businesses
