## Eligible Groups:

- Adopt A Highway Registered Groups (funds will go to your designated organization)
- Civic Groups
- 4-H Clubs, Scouts, Youth Organizations/Groups
- Businesses (funds will go to your designated charitable organization)

## **Program Guidelines:**

- \$100 per mile
- Minimum of 1 mile and up to 10 miles per group
- Up to 150 miles will be funded; please register early

## How to Participate:

- Register with PCCVB by April 1st, 2024
- Pick up supplies at PCCVB Office Marlinton
- Snap a photo of the volunteers
- Turn in your post pick-up report of miles
- Funds are distributed!
